





Currently, 47.2% of the 26,796 housing units in the area are owner occupied; 45.4%, renter occupied; and 7.4% are vacant. Currently, in the U.S., 56.0% of the housing units in the area are owner occupied; 32.8% are renter occupied; and 11.2% are vacant. In 2010, there were 24,774 housing units in the area - 51.3% owner occupied, 41.9% renter occupied, and 6.8% vacant. The annual rate of change in housing units since 2010 is 3.55%. Median home value in the area is \$194,179, compared to a median home value of \$218,492 for the U.S. In five years, median value is projected to change by 2.21% annually to \$216,652.
